Through innovative learning and teaching methods in the field of distance learning, FERNFH takes on a pioneering role as a specialist in academic online education, distance learning, and blended learning in Austria.

All six federally funded degree programs are accredited by AQ Austria, the Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation Austria. Ferdinand Porsche FERNFH charges the statutory tuition fees of €363.36 per semester plus the ÖH contribution for the accredited distance learning programs. In addition, FERNFH offers master's programs, academic courses, certificate programs, and 35 micro-credentials. FERNFH is a subsidiary of FernFH Management & Service GmbH.
